1) Call to Order – Roll Call

The meeting of the Operations Committee was called to order at 6:46 p.m. by Chairperson Zopp.

a) Approval of the September 16, 2024, Meeting Minutes

Motion by Nancy Wild, second by Joseph Bonnett, to Approve. Motion carried by acclamation.

2) Discussion & Possible Action

a) Discussion and Possible Action for the Reallocation of New DPW Facility Funds to Demo Old DPW Facility

Introduced by Janssen followed by discussion. The committee consensus was to proceed with reallocating remaining capital funds for the New DPW Facility for the demolition and environmental cleanup of the Old DPW Facility on S Center St and directed staff to bring back a Resolution to the next committee meeting for approval of such. The committee also requested that a developer agreement be approved by Council prior to any redevelopment of the S Center St frontage, that owner occupied vs. rental property development be clarified, and that a walking path connection be made from S Center St to Smythe Park as part of the redevelopment.

b) Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Ordinance for Heavy Traffic Routes

Introduced by Manthe, followed by discussion. Bonnett has some concerns with how the ordinance is enforced and signage requirements. Zopp requested that fines be added to the ordinance in alignment with state statute. The committee directed staff to finalize the ordinance and map (along with a bullet point list of how heavy traffic routes were selected) and bring such back to committee for approval.
