c) Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Ordinance for Heavy Traffic Routes

d) Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Parking on Rowell Street

Introduced by Zopp, followed by discussion. Kirsh and Klein spoke in opposition to the Committee's prior decision to no longer allow perpendicular/angle parking on Rowell Street, citing hardships for their businesses due to the reduced amount of available on street parking spaces parallel parking would cause. Upon further discussion, the committee consensus was to proceed with an ordinance revision to allow perpendicular/angle parking on the south side of Rowell Street while eliminating all on street parking on the north side of Rowell Street. This would also require an offset centerline to be painted on Rowell Street to clearly define the travel lanes on the street. Kirsh, Baxter and Klein were all favorable to this decision by the committee.
