1) Call to Order – Roll Call

The meeting of the Operations Committee was called to order at 6:47p.m. by Chairperson Joe Bonnett. a) Approval of the August 18, 2025 Meeting Minutes

Motion by Cris Olson, second by Jennifer Hiley, to approve. Motion carried by acclamation.

2) Discussion & Possible Action

a) Regarding a Resolution Authorizing the Complete and Final Report on Estimated Special Assessments for the Madison Street Reconstruction Project

Introduced by Janssen, followed by discussion. Motion by Jennifer Hiley, second by Nancy Wild, to approve. Motion carried by acclamation.

b) Regarding Additional On-Street Handicap Accessible Parking Stalls on Gilmore Avenue

Introduced by Janssen, followed by discussion. Hiley suggested adding two additional handicap accessible stalls, one west and one east of the current locations. Olson suggested adding one additional handicap accessible stall and then reevaluate at a future date to determine if they are being consistently used and if more are needed, with which Anderson agreed. Flaherty suggested that, however many stalls are added, signage should be posted that indicates they are only for use during game days. Hiley will follow up with the Little League Commissioner(s) to determine if they've heard anything from league members with regard to requesting additional on-street handicap accessible parking stalls. Motion by Olson to table this item until after Hiley follows up with the Little League Commissioner(s), second by Flaherty. Motion carried by acclamation.

c) Regarding Current Parking Restrictions on Bogert Street

Introduced by Janssen, followed by discussion. Olson, Anderson, and Flaherty all recommended no changes to the existing ordinance with specific regards to this item. Motion by Flaherty to not change the current ordinance, seconded by Anderson. Motion carried by acclamation.

- d) Regarding an Ordinance Amending Section 62-50, Parking Restrictions, for East Burnett Street

Introduced by Janssen, followed by discussion. Motion by Flaherty to restrict parking on the south side of E Burnett St from McKinley St to Fletcher Rd, no second. Motion by Anderson to approve the ordinance amendment as presented, second by Olson. Motion carried by acclamation.
